## 140,000 Relatives from 179 Countries Waiting: A Zion Opportunity for Each of Us

  provide access to premium genealogy resources and records. These genealogy resources include many
  subscription-based family history websites at no charge for their use. URL for finding a center is

- Return to the Relatives at RootsTech page or the FamilySearch Family Tree mobile app to see any relatives and how you are related. You can even send a message.

This is a wonderful opportunity for each of us know this information but to also walk them through various options that are available to view their living relationships around the world and connect to a wide variety of cousins that they didn't even know existed. Presently over 179,000 people representing at least 179 countries have registered with either virtual or onsite attendance at the Salt Palace in Salt Lake City. My guess based on past experiences, it could reach at least 500,000+ people in 200+ countries world-wide. In addition, there were 128,000 livestream hours from their online attendees, 400+ classes offered, 250 topics of learning, 236 countries and territories, 156 industry friends, and 15 languages. Yes, it is the largest genealogical conference in the world with FREE for virtual attendance.



My family history colleague found out last year that his college roommate who became one of my best friends is a direct cousin. Not only that but his wife (who happened to be his wife's college roommate) was also a distant cousin! Below he has over 9,000 relatives that he has been already linked to from the RootsTech 2024 registration. The screenshot below came from my "Relatives at RootsTech 2024" home page this morning and shows that 9,047 of his living relatives have opted into this resource in the last day and a half. Your relatives listed may vary but even if the number is limited it's still an opportunity to become more aware of living relatives and perhaps connect. It's a great opportunity to show our Savior that we are ready and willing to build a Zion society! Just since my colleague sent me this information, his relative count for those who have opted in this year went up to 15,000+!



This awesome resource will be available at least through the end of March 31, 2024 so don't delay in registering for RootsTech 2024 as it is absolutely free through their virtual registration in which you can video stream most of the conference's presentations for the next two years all without any charges. Please take some time to learn how to navigate this tool, read the FAQs cited below and start helping those you know and associate with become familiar with this limited time opportunity.

My wife presently has 936 relatives listed and registered along with three in Denmark and two in Canada besides the U.S. continent and Alaska. What's so interesting about these relatives, you not only can accurately view the lineage between that person and you, but you can also text message them directly to initiate a continuing dialogue between you both. Below is a map that geographically illustrates the locations of my wife's living relatives currently registered for the RootsTech 2024 Conference. And will certainly become substantially larger once the conference begins on February 29<sup>th</sup> to March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024.
