But most people *are* curious about the nearer degrees of cousinhood in their own families. And in cases where someone dies without a will, cousinship can be the basis for a claim on the estate. In the five years since Howard Hughes died, more than 500 people have claimed to be his cousin, and the courts are still trying to determine who are legitimate heirs. Grant was a sixth cousin once removed of Grover Cleveland and a fourth cousin of Franklin D. Roosevelt. In my Church ward or parish, there is a women who is related to 42 of the 45 USA Presidents, 29 passengers on the Mayflower, every prophet in our church since Joseph Smith born in 1805-1844 to our present-day Prophet, Seer and Revelator, Russell M. Nelson and Royalty in UK, Scotland, Denmark and Norway. And because she is related to European royalty, she was able to trace her descendants back to 79 A.D. How did she obtain such information so specifically and easily? She used the BYU Relative Finder at <https://www.relativefinder.org/#/main>. The prerequisite it that one must have a FamilySearch account which is free. For finding these relationships, there are also categories of special details available while searching for **Famous Americans, Entertainers, Constitution and Declaration Signers, Authors & Poets, Prophets, European Royalty, and more**. *Relative Finder* works by comparing two family trees to search for common ancestors by connecting simultaneously with your relatives from around the entire globe! 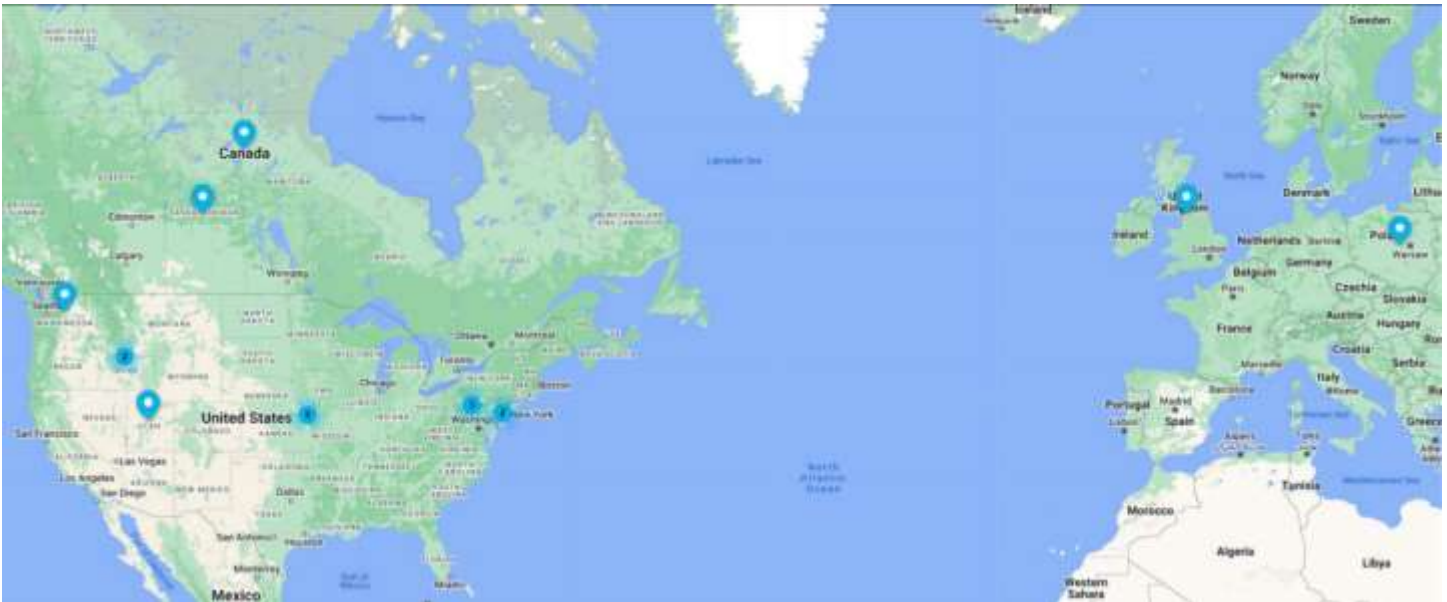
Closing Comments


What are **kissing cousins**? “One who is a relative known well enough to be greeted with a kiss.”

Technically, cousins are people who share a common ancestor that is at least 2 generations away, such as a grandparent or great-grandparent. You and your siblings are not cousins because your parents are only 1 generation away from you. What is the order of a cousin’s chart? Below are two charts obtained from FamilySearch.org to better illustrate these many differ relationships in defining cousins more accurately.



There are 24 people from RootsTech 2023 Conference that I am related to ranging from 3rd cousins to 6th cousins living in Canada, UK, Poland and coast-to-coast in the USA from the State of Washington to New Jersey. I contacted every one of them and one of them through their messaging service was a fifth cousin, once removed, who actually is located in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan 1,000 miles from Denver who has the very same great-great-great-great-grandfather as me born in 1725 in Austria-Hungary: Timotheius Kuzmicz 1725- 1800 and Eufemia or Fevronia. 1739 -1799. See the geographical locations of my newly found cousins on the map inserted below. At some future date, this website will allow me to share original media documents much like Ancestry does and you don't need an expensive Ancestry account to view these original documents. I do have a Kuzmich family history blog which also works well at: <https://kuzmichgenealogy.blogspot.com> with good verbal insight introductions and appropriate media to my family history endeavors on both my paternal and maternal lines from Poland, Slovenia and Ukraine. But if you use the **BYU Relative Finder**, you are dealing with a far greater capacity of locating cousins because FamilySearch which has more than 1.2 billion ancestors that is the largest collection of free family history, family tree, and genealogy records in the world. So why not start with the very best TOP FAMILY HISTORY RESEARCH RESOURCES readily available?! The fastest way to learn tricks and tips in learning/using FamilySearch.org can be found at **The Family History Guide** at <https://www.thefhguide.com/> and then there are ten pull-down menus for FamilySearch covering: 1) Family Tree, 2) Memories, 3) Descendants, 4) Discover, 5) Indexing, 6) Help, 7) Technology, 8) DNA, 9) Family Tree App and 10) Memories App. I also set up BYU Relative Finder for my ward so the entire congregation can easily learn if they related to anybody.
