1. How many president were 45 or younger when they were inaugurated?

First go to organize and click on "Show All Records". Then go to Browse pull down menu and select "Find".

Under the field, "Political Party" type in "WHIG" and see how many presidents were democrats.
5. Which party won the presidency election the most times?

First go to organize and click on "Show All Records". Then go to Browse pull down menu and select "Find".

Under the field, "Political Party" write in Republican and see how many presidents were

Republican. Highest number wins!!
6 . What is the most common occupation of the president?
First go to organize and click on "Show All Records". Then go to Browse pull down menu and select "Find".

Under the field "occupation" type in doctor, repeat the process with farmer ad then lawyer. One of these occupations wins hands down.
7. Who was president for the longest period of time?

First go to organize and click on "Show All Records". Then go to Browse pull down menu and select "Find".

Under the term "terms served" type in " $>2$ " only one president has served more than 2 terms and that was?
8. When Monroe was elected, who was president before him?

First go to organize and click on "Show All Records". Then go to Browse pull down menu and select "Find".

Under the field "last name" type in Monroe. He was president \# ?. To find the president before that president?
9. To which political party did Washington belong?
