

Ultra-Family Reunion Activity: Part 7: Your FamilySearch Account Data Incorporated in Customized, Personal On-Line Jeopardy Games - Either In-person on a TV or remotely on videoconferencing Over the Internet

Over July 4th weekend, my family hosted its annual Kuzmich Family Reunion here in the Denver area. To my surprise, my son, Dallin upgraded and customized the available Jeopardy TV game templates with extensive research and photos taken from the memory sections of both the paternal and maternal sides of my wife's and my ancestral family lines. Hence, nobody (neither my wife or me, or 4 children and their spouses and 9 grandchildren) knew all the answers because of the lengthy data and photos in our FamilySearch accounts. And when we did answer the questions, others added more personal stories to further enlighten this unique, creative Jeopardy TV Game show format based solely on our extensive FamilySearch memories. Below are some images of these questions and their answers. When we finished the first jeopardy game, my son calmly said, "now let's play double jeopardy with another complete original game to further instill our family roots in the USA and in both western and Eastern Europe. 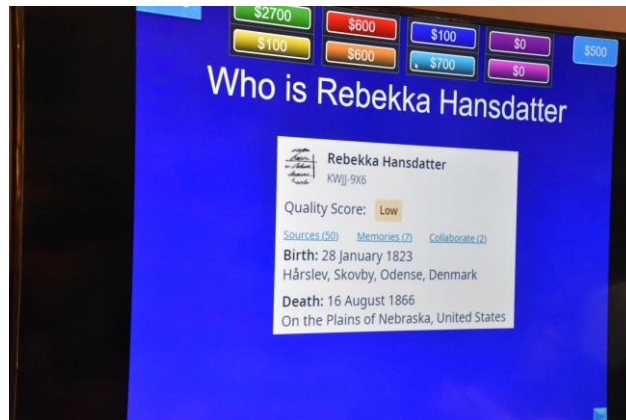
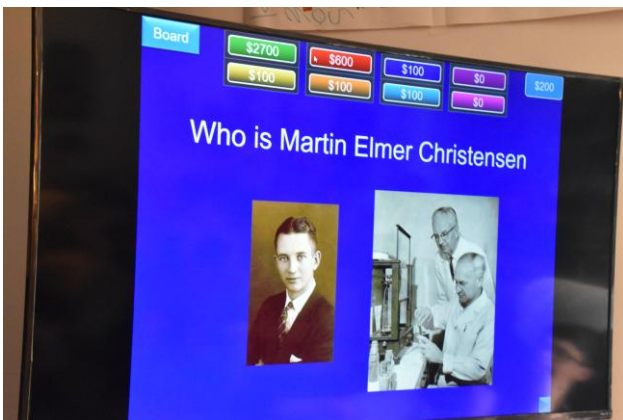
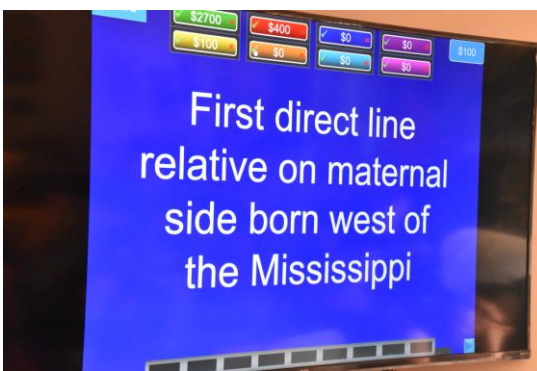
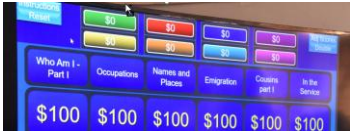


Family

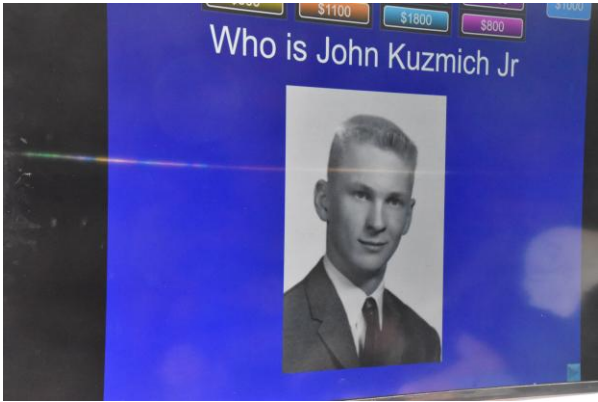
